Breaking Down the FAA's Three-Year Life-Limit Rule

On July 20th, the FAA filed its final ruling on "Re-Registration and Renewal of Aircraft Registration." This new rule will impact the entire private aircraft industry and confusion abounds. This rule will terminate the registration of all aircraft registered before October 1, 2010, and will require the re-registration of each aircraft in order to retain U.S. civil aircraft status. These amendments also establish a system for a 3-year recurrent expiration and renewal of registration for all aircraft issued registration certificates on or after October 1, 2010.
