HISTORIC DC-3 AIRCRAFT TO BE ON DISPLAY AT DANBURY AIRPORT.

The recently restored Flagship Detroit airplane, an original DC-3 delivered to American Airlines in 1937 will be on display at the Danbury Airport City Ramp on Friday, September 17th from 12 noon to 6:00 pm. Local flights will begin boarding at 10:00 am on Saturday the 18th.

Owned & operated by a private volunteer foundation, the aircraft has just recently completed a major restoration to return the exterior/interior to the original configuration. Members of the Foundation will be on hand to provide tours and answer questions about this historic aircraft.

On Saturday, an opportunity to join the foundation & enjoy a "Ride Back in Time" (Flight around Candlewood Lake) will be available for a tax-deductible donation of \$150.
